

General Payment and Delivery Conditions Drive2pass

1. These General Payment and Delivery Conditions apply to all services offered by Drive2pass, unless otherwise agreed in writing.
2. If a point from these General Payment and Delivery Conditions is deviated from, the remaining points remain in full force and effect.
- 3a. Every driving lesson agreement concluded (also verbally and by telephone) between Drive2pass and the student is considered binding.
- 3b. If the first driving lesson of the starter package has been taken by the student, the student is obliged to take all lessons up to the practical exam at the client. In addition, the student agrees to the General Delivery and Payment Conditions of Drive2pass from the first driving lesson.
- 3c. Trial lessons do not fall under point 3a and 3b.
- 4a. All agreed lessons must be canceled at least 24 hours before the start of the lesson.
- 4b. If you do not show up for an agreed lesson, the lesson will be charged or deducted from the agreed lesson package.
- 4c. Points 4a and 4b do not apply in case of emergency hospitalization or funeral or cremation of a close relative at the time of the agreed lesson or exam.
- 4d. It is possible to cancel an already agreed lesson package. The tuition fees for the outstanding classes will be refunded pro rata minus 25% of the amount to be refunded as compensation for costs incurred. 4th. Reimbursement of an exam once reserved at the CBR is not possible.
- 4f. If due to vacation of the student the already reserved exam cannot take place and the student has not passed this vacation on to the applicant of the CBR, full charging of the costs incurred to the student will follow.
- 5a. Only when the student is in possession of a valid theory certificate for the category for which he wants to take the practical exam, the practical exam and the interim test can be requested.
- 5b. A practical exam is only reserved after payment of the costs by the student.
- 6a. All individual lessons must be paid in cash immediately or within 7 days.
- 6b. Payments by means of a transfer must be deposited into the account of Drive2pass in the week of the driving lesson taken.
- 6c. Payments on invoice must be made within 14 days of the invoice date, but at the latest before the start of the first driving lesson.
- 6d. Payments for delivered driving lessons and the practical exam must be credited to the account of Drive2pass before the start date of the practical exam. Otherwise, Drive2pass reserves the right not to allow the already reserved practical exam to take place before all outstanding items have been paid.
7. If the student fails to make his payment in accordance with Articles 4 and 6, an interest of at least 1.25% per month will be charged, calculated from the due date of the invoice. General Payment and Delivery Conditions Drive2pass

8. If Drive2pass is forced to outsource the collection of its claim due to the student's nonperformance, the student will owe Drive2pass the interest owed, collection costs and any legal costs in addition to the payment of the principal or the remainder thereof.
9. Drive2pass is not responsible for cancellations of exams by the CBR.
10. Driving to the CBR for a practical exam or test will be counted as a practical lesson.
11. The rental of the car and hourly wage of the instructor after the practical exam or test will be counted as a practical lesson of 30 minutes for CBR Eemnes/emmerloord and Amsterdam for CBR elsewhere will be counted 45 minutes.
12. If the driving lessons cannot take place due to bad weather conditions, the costs will not be passed on to the student.
13. All exam requests by Drive2pass are requested from the CBR and is registered with the CBR under driving school number 1536X9.
14. Drive2pass reserves the right to change agreements made within a reasonable term.
15. The student declares that he has not been denied the right to drive motor vehicles by court decision, nor that his driver's license has been recovered.
16. If, despite legal restrictions, Drive2pass still gives driving lessons to a student, or if it turns out that the statement obtained by the student when providing personal data is incorrect or incomplete, the student indemnifies "Drive2pass fully and will reimburse the fines imposed, as well as all other financial consequences.
17. Drive2pass ensures that instruction is only given by instructors (-instructors) who comply with the provisions as set out in the WRM (Motor Vehicle Education Act).
18. The student is responsible for having an identity document with him during the lessons.
19. Intangible or material damage to the student cannot be recovered from Drive2pass.
20. The student is responsible and must not be under the influence of harmful substances during the driving lesson. The consequences of this are for the account of the Student.
21. The student agrees that the necessary private information for following the driver training is known to the tax authorities and accountant.
22. Private data will be kept according to the rules of the tax authorities.
23. Pass guarantee only applies if drive 2 pass agrees with your exam. If drive 2 pass does not agree with this and the student still wants to take the exam, the guarantee does not apply.
Pass guarantee expires after 1 resit/exam.
